"The Naturalization Gallery"

A two year joint project of The Cornwall and Area Watershed Group, The P.E.I. Dept. of Forestry, The MacPhail Woods Ecological Forestry Group and the students and staff of Eliot River School designed to enhance the walking trail at The Terry Fox Center by creating a unique, showpiece, natural venue for both students and the general public to enjoy. When completed this exciting project will offer the trail user the opportunity to become acquainted with and to learn the characteristics of most native trees and shrubs to P.E.I..

This two phase project was started in the spring of 2015, with over 600 trees and shrubs planted and will see another large planting in the spring of 2016. Our official opening is slated for Canada Day 2016.

As part of the project in the spring of 2016 we will be planting larger "Memorial Trees", both along the trail and in a Memorial Grove, which will be situated adjacent to the toboggan hill. The general public are invited to purchase a tree(s) in memory of a loved one.
